**Statement of Principle**

EQUINE CANADA (EC), The National Equestrian Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

**Equine Canada is committed to:**

1. Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
  2. Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
  3. Ensuring that Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors or their respective agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses, as well as horses placed under their care for any purpose.
  4. Providing for the continuous well being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
  5. Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare; increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
  6. Requiring owners, trainers & exhibitors to know & follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
  7. Reviewing, revising, & developing competition rules & regulations that protect the welfare of horses.
- The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which is a reasonable person, informed & experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibiting procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.



**2018 Jump Canada Levy.** Jump Canada Board is a Committee of Equine Canada responsible for the promotion and enhancement of the hunter/jumper discipline. As a Gold C Recognized National Equestrian Canada Hunter Jumper competition, the Annapolis Valley Exhibition will remit \$20.00 per horse/pony entered to the Jump Canada Board. (G106.2) This amount will be collected from each competitor at the time of entry.

These funds will be used to support a number of regional and national programs designed to foster the activities of hunter/jumper riders, owners and the industry at large. 60% Hunter, Young Rider and Domestic Programs; 37.5% National and International Teams; 2.5 % Administration, Publicity and PR. 40% of domestic portion is returned to the province in which it is generated.

### **COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

“Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in an any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in the EC-sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition.” (A602.7)

#### **1. EQUINE CANADA SPORT LICENCES & NSEF MEMBERSHIPS required**

**EC (A203) Sport Licences required for all Owners & Riders. Please include copies. A204, A205, A206, A207**

**Amateurs must have current credentials. A902 and G110.**

**Non-member EC Temporary Sport Licence is \$45.00 (for each rider and owner). No points go forward. Single Event Sport Licence upgrade \$40.00 per Show (Bronze to Gold); \$20.00 per Show (Silver to Gold) NSEF MEMBERSHIP (or PTSO membership) is required.**

- 2. MANDATORY LIABILITY INSURANCE** - Photocopy of NSEF membership – enclose with entry  
- Photocopy of EC Membership card – enclose with entry

#### **3. EC HORSE RECORDINGS**

**EC Horse Recordings/EC National Passports/FEI Passports**

a. All Canadian entries are required to have an EC Horse Recording with a valid EC horse license to compete (A402), or if owned by a temporary sport license holder a Temporary Horse Registration form must be purchased at each competition entered. Foreign entries must sign an affidavit (A404).

b. Exception: Lead line riders, and horses competing in only the hack division.

**THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF EACH HORSE RECORDING MUST BE ON EVERY ENTRY FORM FOR THE CORRESPONDING HORSE/PONY. Temporary horse registration is \$45.00 – no points to go forward.**

**4. HEADGEAR** – See A905 and G102 At all times, persons mounted at an EC-sanctioned event must wear approved protective headgear, certified by ASTM, or SEI; BSI/BSEN; EN or AS/NZS and properly fitted and securely fastened by a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet.

**4a. DRESS CODE:** See G109

**5. MEASUREMENT OF PONIES** - Ponies will be measured in Barn # 8, Thursday, 9:00 am  
(Please inform Ex Office, when picking up back number, if measurement is required)

**6. HEALTH OF ANIMALS** - It is advised that all entries should have been immunized against equine Influenza and rhino within one year. It is suggested that this should have been done at least one month before the show in case of reaction. Any animal which appears in the opinion of the Exhibition veterinarian, to be ill, will leave the grounds. It is also advised that all entries be Coggins tested within the previous six months.

**7. DRUG TESTING** - \$7.00 per horse/pony - EC Competition

Any horse/pony entered in any class at an EC competition may be selected for equine medication control testing, while at the event location.

**8. STALLIONS** - Stallions shall be barred from any class, the conditions of which specify that a junior is to ride or drive except as provided for in division rules. Decisions as to the manageability of stallions is at the discretion of the Judge or Steward.

**9. CROSS ENTRIES** between Sections allowed where eligible.

**10. STABLING** - Please remember that there are a LIMITED NUMBER of BOX STALLS.

Do not rearrange Stalls or Stabling. No Light Horse entries will be accepted after suitable accommodations are filled due to limited space. The Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries. **Exhibitors must show in 3 or more classes for stabling.**

**11. CANCELLATION OF CLASSES** - If less than 5 entries in a Class, the Committee reserves the right to cancel the Class. Every effort will be made to notify Exhibitors (by phone) if classes are cancelled. Hunter Divisions may be combined, if necessary.

**12. REFUNDS** - There will be no refund without a Vet's or Doctor's certificate after closing date. Refunds will be made within 2 weeks following Show.

**13. JUMP ORDERS** - will be posted - ½ hour before Hunter classes; 1 hour before Jumper classes  
Please register cancellations & withdrawals prior to class with Ring Clerk - PA Booth, Main Ring

**14. Hors Concours** – Not allowed in Hunter (G401); may be allowed in Jumper G501  
- allowed only if ring time permits; entry fees apply.

**15. PRIZE MONEY (EC Show)** - will be mailed.

**16. PROVINCIAL AWARDS** - All those working towards Provincial Championship Points will please enter the animal in the name of the owner who is the official Equine Canada member and include owner's Equine Canada No. on Entry Form. Rider must have Equine Canada membership No. also.

**17. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST REPORT TO EXHIBITION OFFICE** (Red Bldg) before stabling, and to **RING CLERK, PA BOOTH** (beside Main Ring) - before showing.

**18. CLASS TIMES** - Owing to the length of the Horse Show Program no delays will be tolerated. All entries must enter the ring immediately when a class is called. When the gate is closed, no further entries will be admitted.

**19. ARRIVAL & EXIT - HORSES/PONIES (EQUINE CANADA SHOW)** Stalls will not be available until Wednesday mid afternoon. Hunters must exit Stalls immediately following last class - due to arrival of Jumpers (Except for Hunters showing in Jumper classes also). Stalls to be cleaned before departure.

**All entries and exits will be made by the West Gate on the Exhibition grounds.**

**20. HORSE TRAILERS Parking (no charge)** must be parked in reserved area in Parking Lot. (Ask Parking Lot attendants).

ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING ON GROUNDS - 12:00 Noon to Midnight.

**TRAILER COURT** - for Exhibitors only, is located on the grounds - \$14.37/night; \$86.25/wk.  
This charge includes water and lights, and is payable on entry form.

**PARKING - Cars/Trucks**

One car or 1/2 ton may be parked beside (house) trailer ... beside trailer \$20.00. Outside \$10.00.

**21. BACK NUMBERS (plasticized) \$10.00 Fee - Refund** (after last class) from Ring Clerk, PA Booth  
Must be worn in Show Ring & Practice Ring. **Make sure back number is visible to Judge at all times.**

**22. BEDDING - COMPETITORS TO BRING THEIR OWN**

Hay and Bedding will be for sale – on grounds (back of Cattle Barns) – 7:00-9:00 am

**23. NO CROSS TYING OF HORSES/PONIES IN AISLES.**

**24. SERVICES** - Emergency medical services available on site. Communication on Show grounds by PA System (PA Booth, Main Ring - direct contact with front Office) and handheld radios.

**St. John Ambulance is on the grounds all of Annapolis Valley Exhibition Week.**

**26. Competitors must remain in the ring until ribbons are presented, & are to be in Show Ring attire, Horses/Ponies in Bridles for presentations. (G302).**

To be eligible to show in under saddle class, horse or pony must have competed and completed in at least one course over fences within its division.

Medium to light contact to be maintained. To be judged on 45% performance, 15% conformation and 40% manners. Road Hack horse/pony - flat-footed walk with a reasonably loose rein, trot, strong trot, easy canter, Hand gallop. Only 8 horses to hand gallop at one time. 55% performance, 20% substance, 15% conformation, 10 % manners. Entry fee \$30.00 per division or \$10.00 per class.
