

NSEF Scotia Series Dressage Officials Clinic With FEI 5 Dressage Judge Elizabeth McMullen



NSEF has partnered with Fraser Equestrian Centre to offer an officials clinic for Scotia Series and EC Dressage Judges. NSEF will be hosting the Friday Classroom portion. The Saturday and Sunday portion will be at the Fraser Equestrian Centre's "Raising the Standard – Ride, Coach, Judge Better Dressage Tests" Clinic.

To meet the EC Judge updating requirements, participants must attend the full weekend (Friday through Sunday). To meet the Scotia Series Dressage Module 2 and Module 3 requirements, participants must attend Friday and Saturday and meet standard in the mock judging. Attending Sunday is encouraged.

Participants will register with NSEF for the Friday session and with the clinic organizers for Saturday and Sunday. Please see below for more information.

About the clinician: **Elizabeth (Lib) McMullen** of Tottenham, Ontario, Canada is an accomplished international Dressage judge. In addition to having **achieved the FEI's highest, 5*, accreditation**, Lib is also qualified as an Equestrian Canada Senior Dressage Judge, a USEF Senior Dressage Judge, and an FEI Young Horse Dressage judge. During her judging career Lib has judged FEI competitions in England, Poland, Holland, Australia, Italy, Brazil, Ukraine, Russia, Honduras, Costa Rica, Columbia, France, Spain, Germany, USA, and Canada. As an FEI 5* Dressage judge, Lib is currently (2019) one of only 36 Dressage Judges worldwide, qualified to judge at World Equestrian Games and the Olympic Games. Her judging highlights include:

- The World Equestrian Games in Normandy, France and Jerez, Spain;
- The World Cup Finals in Paris, France and Gothenburg, Sweden;
- Several North American Young Rider Championships;
- The Pan American, Asian, and Central American Games.

A **High Performance Coach**, Lib conducts conducts clinics and seminars throughout Canada, the United States, and Central America. As Guatemala's National Dressage Coach from 2005 - 2011, Lib McMullen guided them to the top of the podium for the Team and Individual Gold, at the 2006 Central American Games.
