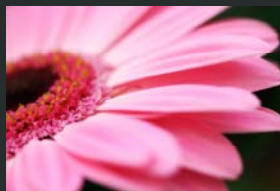

RULES & REGULATIONS

SECTION A: GENERAL REGULATIONS

(A602.1) The Nova Scotia Hunter Spectacular competition is sanctioned as a Gold competition of Equestrian Canada 308 Legget Drive, Suite 100, Ottawa, Ontario, K2K 1Y6 and is governed by the rules of EC.

(A602.2) Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. All questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the show management, whose decision will be final.

(A602.4) It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide to the Horse Show Office proof of membership prior to competing. Anyone competing without proof of 2018 EC Sport License and Valid EC Horse Recording will pay the Temporary Sport License/Temporary Horse Registration fee. These fees are non-refundable upon the completion of the competition.

(A602.5) Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location.

(A602.7) Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in the EC-sanctioned competition in any compacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition. Show management reserves the right to refuse entries based on EC rules.

EC's concussion-related Accidents & Return-to Play Rule came into effect January 1, 2017 for all EC sanctioned competitions in Canada. The full rules can be found in the EC Rules, Section A, General Regulations, Article 101.



EQUESTRIAN CANADA STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLES:

Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction. All Persons shall be committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers, and competitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses place in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Actively promoting the development of and adherence to competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horses.

(A602.3 (f)) The standard by which conduct, or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

PROGRAM CHANGES:

The Nova Scotia Hunter Spectacular reserves the right to make changes to classes, change the order of the classes, to cancel, reschedule, or combine any division they deem advisable. Schedule times may result in an earlier start time based on the number of entries and should be used as a guideline only. Schedule announcements will be published on the **Nova Scotia Hunter Spectacular** Facebook page, at the show office, and posted at the in-gate.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS:

- Thursday: 11:00am – 7:00pm
- Friday: 8:00am – 30mins after final class
- Saturday/Sunday: 7:00am – 30mins after final class

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES:

Arrivals start Thursday, July 12th at 11:00am
Departures to be finalized after last class on Sunday

STABLING:

Limited stabling facilities will be located onsite and is subject to availability. Stabling requests will be date stamped and may be sold out prior to the closing date. Stall reservations are non-refundable. Stall fees are \$35.00 per night, or any part thereof. Stalls must be cleaned out by competitors prior to departure from the grounds. Services will be available for stall cleaning at \$10.00 per stall. Stabling areas will be secured Thursday, Friday and Saturday over-night.

SHAVINGS:

Bedding is provided complementary by the **Nova Scotia Hunter Spectacular Horse Show** and will be available on-site.

ENTRIES:

Entry closing date: Sunday, July 8th, 2018. After this date a \$30.00 post entry fee will be charged. Submit one entry form per horse. Information must be filled in completely to be accepted including signature, address, phone numbers, EC, NSEF, NSHJA where applicable and Horse Recording numbers.

PAYMENT OF ENTRIES:

Email transfers to: nshunterspectacular@gmail.com. Cheques accompanied with entry forms will be accepted. Please make cheques payable to: **NOVA SCOTIA HUNTER SPECTACULAR HORSE SHOW**. No charges or changes will be allowed during the show without payment. Accounts can be left open for the duration of the show with a signed open cheque. All open account charges remaining at the end of the show will be automatically applied to the open cheque.

A \$50.00 charge will be added to accounts that are not closed by the end of the show, including cheques that are post-dated after the final day of the show. A \$50.00 charge will be applied to cheques that are returned for any reason (NSF fee). Unsettled accounts will be turned over to EC, which will result in suspension from all competitions.

ENTRY CHANGES:

Class adds and scratches can only be made in the Horse Show Office and must be received prior to the start of the class. Class adds made on the day-of may also require the exhibitor to compete first in the order of go. No rider can participate in a class in which he or she is not entered. No additions will be allowed at the in-gates.

SCRATCHES:

If any entry is scratched in writing prior to noon on July 8th, 2018 entry fees will be refunded, less administration and stabling fees, which are NON-REFUNDABLE. After this time, no fees will be refunded without an original copy of a Doctor or Veterinarian certificate. The administration fee and stabling fee are non-refundable under any circumstances. Owners will be liable for all fees if not scratched in this manner.

HORSE SUBSTITUTIONS:

Horse substitutions will only be permitted prior to the closing date of entries at no charge.

PRIZE MONEY:

Payout of prize money will be at the completion of each class to the rider.

MEMBERSHIP RULES:

- Trainer & Person Responsible: EC Gold Sport License, NSEF Membership or equivalent. In the case of junior/minor owner entries, a parent/guardian is entitled to sign as PR.
- Owner & Riders: EC Gold Sport License, NSEF Membership or equivalent, NSHJA required only to accrue Provincial points.
- Amateur Riders: EC Amateur Status
- Juniors: Date of Birth
- Horses & Ponies: A402 - Horse Recordings are mandatory for all horses and ponies entering EC sanctioned competitions when required by discipline/breed sport rules and must be available at the competition (See Article A411 - EC National Passport or FEI Passport Unavailable).

ADMINISTRATION:

- Administration Fee: \$30.00
- Paramedic Fee: \$5.00
- Drug Testing: An amount of \$7.00 for drug tests will be added (amount to be remitted to Equestrian Canada). Any horse entered in any class at a competition may, while on the competition grounds may be selected for equine medication control testing.
- JC Levy: As a recognized national competition, an amount of \$20.00 will be collected per horse entered in the Hunter divisions for remittance to the Jumping Committee, to support their development programs.

PONY MEASUREMENT:

Available on Saturday, July 14th 30 minutes prior to the first pony EC rated class. Reserve through the Show Office.

DOGS:

All dogs must be on a leash at all times. Owners are required to abide by the "Poop and Scoop" by-law.

NUMBERS:

A number will not be issued to anyone who has not paid or left an open cheque when the number is picked up. Every entry must be provided an identification number, which must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling/exercise areas as well as the competition ring. Any horse wearing the incorrect number may not be scored.

DRESS CODE:

Proper attire is required for all competitors starting Friday morning and for the remainder of the show. Formal attire is encouraged for all stakes, classics and feature classes.

BLACKSMITHS:

A farrier is available during the days of competition. Payment must be made directly to the farrier once services have been rendered.

VETERINARIANS:

On call.

NO SMOKING:

There will be no smoking allowed in any building or within 10 meters of a public entrance as per the applicable by-laws.

SCHOOLING:

The ring will be available on Thursday, July 12th, 2018 from 12:00pm - 6:00pm with a paid schooling ticket. A fee of \$25.00 must be paid in advance through your entry or at the show office. A maximum of five ponies/horses are permitted in the schooling ring at one time. Pre-arranged times may be available for groups.

LUNGING:

Lunging is available in the designated area only at the following scheduled times or otherwise posted:

THURSDAY: 11:00am – 8:00pm

FRIDAY: 5:00am – 8:30am

SATURDAY/SUNDAY: 5:00am – 7:00am

HELMETS:

Helmets are mandatory and must be worn by anyone mounted on a horse on the show grounds, with safety harness correctly fastened. It is the responsibility of the rider, the parent/guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to confirm headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards, is properly fitted, and in good condition (A905, G102).

VEHICLES:

All vehicles must be parked in designated areas only.

HORS CONCOURS:

As per A808, there will be no HORS Concours allowed in any class.

WASH RACKS:

Participants are only allowed to bathe their ponies/horses in designated area.

GROUND ACCESS & NIGHT SECURITY:

The show grounds will be secured Thursday, Friday and Saturday overnight.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES

These trophies are presented each year. Trophies must be returned to the Show Committee by March 1st of the following year.

SCHOOLING CLASSES

THURSDAY – OPEN SCHOOLING **ENTRY FEE \$25**

Class #1 - The ring will be opened on Thursday, July 12th, 2018 from 12:00pm - 6:00pm with a paid schooling ticket. The fee must be paid in advance through your entry or at the show office. A maximum of five ponies/horses are permitted in the schooling ring at one time. Pre-arranged times may be available for groups.

FRIDAY – SCHOOLING HUNTER **ENTRY FEE \$25**

Class #2: Available to any pony/horse competing on Friday, July 13th. Must be completed before their first over fences course entered. Ponies/horses are allowed **ONE** schooling round. No ribbons or prize money.

SATURDAY – SCHOOLING HUNTER **ENTRY FEE \$25**

Class #2b: Available to any pony/horse competing on Saturday, July 14th. Must be completed before their first over fences course entered. Ponies/horses are allowed **ONE** schooling round. No ribbons or prize money.

DIVISION #1 - SHORT/LONG STIRRUP HUNTER

DIVISION #2 - LOW MODIFIED HUNTER

DIVISION #3 - MODIFIED HUNTER

These divisions are intended as an introduction to horse showing for riders not ready for the regular pony and hunter divisions.

UNRATED HUNTER DIVISIONS (EC G301.5)

- Not eligible for EC awards
- EC Membership is required.

DIVISION #1: SHORT/LONG STIRRUP HUNTER **ENTRY FEE \$60**

Class #: 3/4/5: Short Stirrup Hunter will be open to Junior "C" riders. Riders are classified as Junior "C" if they are under 12 on Jan.1. Long Stirrup Hunter will be open to Junior "B" and "A" riders. Riders are classified as a Junior "B" if they are 12,13 or 14 on Jan 1. Riders are classified Junior "A" if they are 15,16,17 on Jan 1. Riders in this division may not cross enter into any rated division at this competition. Riders must enter and complete at least one over fences class in the division to be eligible to compete in the Under-Saddle Class. Ponies or horses may enter. Suitability is a factor. Horses and ponies may show in other classes with a different rider. This division will jump a course of hunter style jumps not to exceed 2'. Jogging for soundness is not required.

DIVISION #2: LOW MODIFIED HUNTER **ENTRY FEE \$60** *There is no age limit for showing in this division.*

Riders may NOT cross enter into any Rated Hunter Division.

Class #: 6/7/8: Open to all children and adult amateur rider designations as per EC rules, guidelines, and limitations. Courses will be made up of hunter style jumps and set at a height not to exceed 2.3". Classes will be run per EC rules, guidelines, and limitations. Jogging for soundness is not required.

DIVISION #3: MODIFIED HUNTER **ENTRY FEE \$60** *There is no age limit for showing in this division.*

Riders may NOT cross enter into any Rated Hunter Division.

Class #: 9/10/11: Open to all children and adult amateur rider designations as per EC rules, guidelines, and limitations. Courses will be made up of hunter style jumps and set at a height not to exceed 2.6". Classes will be run per EC rules, guidelines, and limitations. Jogging for soundness is not required.

Miscellaneous Divisions and Classes cont'd...

DIVISION #4: BABY GREEN HUNTER

ENTRY FEE \$60

Class #: 12/13/14: Open to horses that have not competed in an EC sanctioned Gold or Silver competition (or equivalent) prior to January 1st of the current year. To maintain their Baby Green status, horses may not compete in any over fences division at an EC sanctioned competition higher than 2'6". Height is 2'6". Jogging for soundness is not required.

DIVISION #5: PERFORMANCE HUNTER 3'

ENTRY FEE \$60

Class #: 15/16/17: Open to all horses. Jogging for soundness is not required.

DIVISION #6: NSHJA PERFORMANCE HUNTER 3'3"/3'6"

ENTRY FEE \$60

Class #: 3'3": 18/19/20 and 3'6": 18.1/19.1/20.1: Open to all horses. NSHJA is offering members Year-End Championship and Incentives at each height: Champion \$250 Reserve \$100. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners and way of going. Horses to be jogged for soundness. EC Membership is required. NSHJA Membership is required to accumulate points.

EC Rated Hunter Divisions

RATED HUNTER DIVISIONS (EC G401/G407)

All hunters are judged on their jumping style, manners and way of going. Hunter under saddle to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; at least eight horses, at the judge's discretion, if available, may be required to gallop one way in the ring but never more than eight at one time (pre-green and green hunters not to gallop). Light contact with the horse's mouth is permissible. In order to maintain awards, horses must compete and complete the course in at least one over fences class in their respective division. Horses are judged from the time they enter the ring until the time they leave. In all hunter classes, horses and ponies must be jogged for soundness (Article G406.2)

The NS Hunter Spectacular Horse Show is pleased to offer six \$750 Stake Classes. Each stake class is open to horse/rider combinations that have competed in the corresponding division. All EC rules and guidelines per divisions will apply to the applicable stake class. All classes are judged on their jumping style, manners and way of going. One round stake class with numerical scoring. Stake round may contain multiple single jumps, roll backs, bending lines or longer lines. Each stake class will run separately from other hunter classes. Formal attire is optional but encouraged. Points will be assigned for year-end awards. Commemorative plate and cooler provided to each first-place winning entry. Ribbons to 8th place.

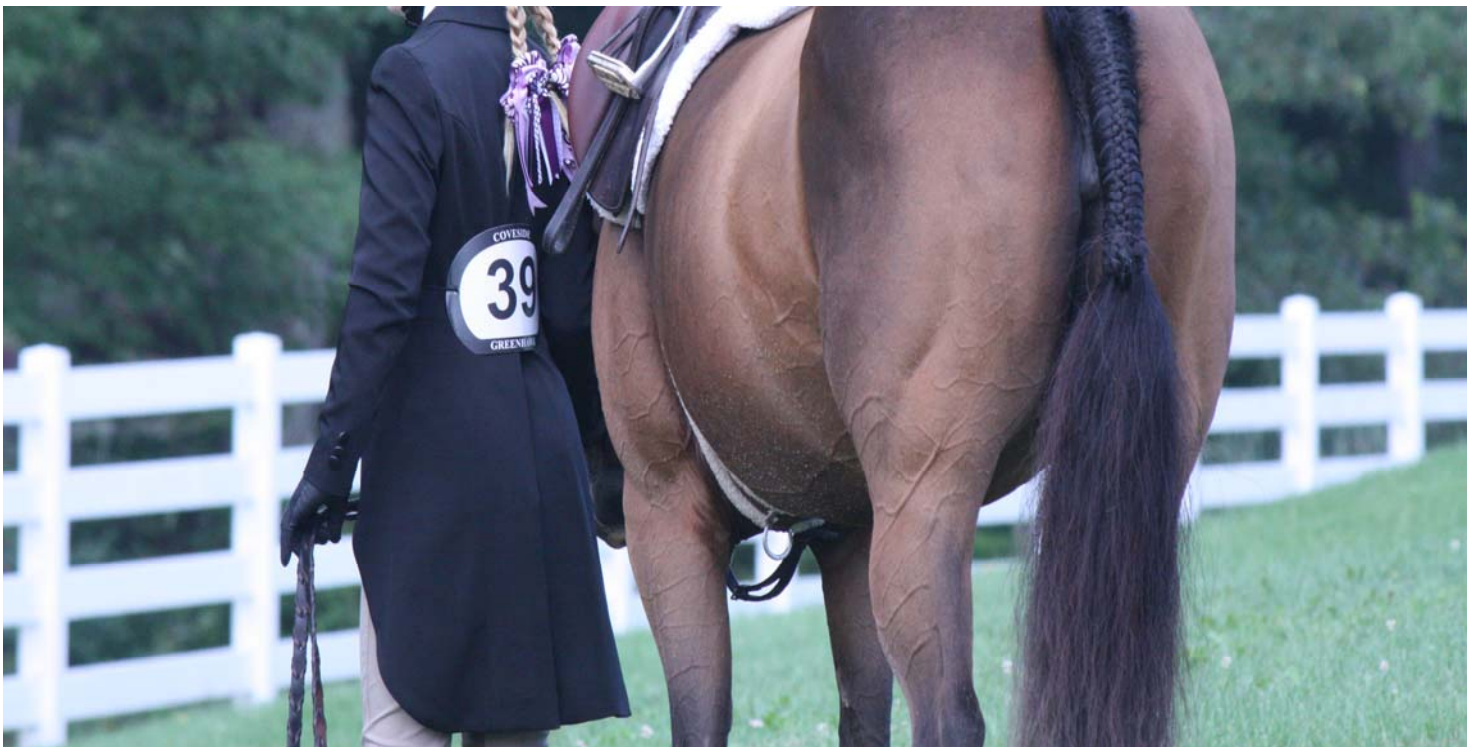

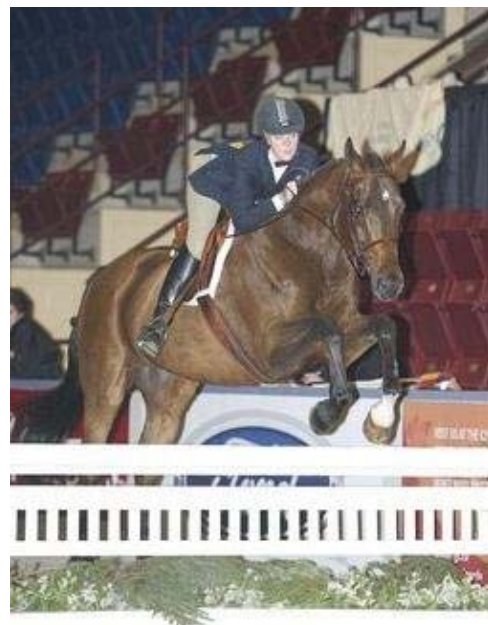

The \$1500 Pony Hunter Classic will be a combined class featuring small (fence height 2'3"), medium (fence height 2'6") and large (fence height 2'9") ponies. The pony classic is open to pony/rider combinations that have competed in the corresponding EC rated pony division. Class will be held as a two round hunter classic. The first round will be a regular hunter classic course jumped at the corresponding fence height. The top 12 entries will return for a second round over a handy hunter course. The second round will be jumped in reverse height order (large-medium-small). Scores from both rounds will be added together to determine the placings. Formal attire is optional but encouraged. Jogging for soundness is required. Points will be assigned for year-end awards. Perpetual trophy and cooler provided to 1st place. Ribbons awarded through 10th place.
