General Regulations

SECTION A: GENERAL REGULATIONS

(A602.1) The Nova Scotia Equestrian Spectacular competition is sanctioned as a Gold and Bronze competition of Equestrian Canada 308 Legget Drive, Suite 100, Ottawa, Ontario, K2K 1Y6 and is governed by the rules of EC.

(A602.2) Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book. All questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the show management, whose decision will be final.

(A602.4) In competitions that require Horse Recording numbers, all Canadian entries are required to hold an EC Horse Recording and have paid the EC Horse Recording annual Activation Fee to compete, or if owned by a temporary sport license holder, a Temporary Horse Registration form must be purchased at each competition entered. Foreign entries must sign an affidavit. (See A404). These fees are non-refundable upon the completion of the competition.

(A602.5) Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control while at the event location.

(A602.7) Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in the EC-sanctioned competition in any compacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition. Show management reserves the right to refuse entries based on EC rules.

EC's concussion-related Accidents & Return-to Play Rule came into effect January 1, 2017 for all EC sanctioned competitions in Canada. The full rules can be found in the EC Rules, Section A, General Regulations, Article 101.



EQUESTRIAN CANADA STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLES:

Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

All Persons shall be committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers, and competitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses place in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Actively promoting the development of and adherence to competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horses.

(A602.3 (f)) The standard by which conduct, or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

Rules & Regulations

PROGRAM CHANGES:

The Nova Scotia Equestrian Spectacular reserves the right to make changes to classes, change the order of the classes, to cancel, reschedule, or combine any division they deem advisable. Schedule times may result in an earlier start time based on the number of entries and should be used as a guideline only. Schedule announcements will be published on the **Nova Scotia Equestrian Spectacular** Facebook page, at the show office, and posted at the in-gate.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS:

- Wednesday: 12:00pm 5:00pm
- Thursday/Friday/Saturday/Sunday:

Open - 30mins prior to first class Close - 30mins after final class

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES:

- Arrivals start Wednesday, June 26th at 12:00pm
- Departures throughout the show as arranged
- Departures to be finalized after last class on Sunday

STABLING:

Limited stabling facilities will be located onsite and is subject to availability. Stabling requests will be date stamped and may be sold out prior to the closing date. Stall reservations are non-refundable. Stall fees are \$35.00 per night, or any part thereof. Stalls must be cleaned out by competitors prior to departure from the grounds. Services will be available for stall cleaning at \$25.00 per stall. Stalls not cleaned out will automatically incur the \$25 cleaning fee to the account.

SHAVINGS:

Loose bedding will be available on-site at a cost of \$20.00.

ENTRIES:

ENTRY CLOSING DATE: SUNDAY, JUNE 16TH, 2019. After this date a \$30.00 post entry fee will be charged. Submit one entry form per horse. Information must be filled in completely to be accepted including signature, address, phone numbers, EC, NSEF, NSHJA where applicable and Horse Recording numbers.

PAYMENT OF ENTRIES:

Email transfers to: nshunterspectacular@gmail.com are preferred. Cheques accompanied with entry forms will be accepted. Please make cheques payable to: NO charges or changes will be allowed during the show without payment. Accounts can be left open for the duration of the show with a signed open cheque. All open account charges remaining at the end of the show will be automatically applied to the open cheque.

A \$50.00 charge will be added to accounts that are not closed by the end of the show, including cheques that are post-dated after the final day of the show. A \$50.00 charge will be applied to cheques that are returned for any reason (NSF fee). Unsettled accounts will be turned over to EC, which will result in suspension from all competitions.

ENTRY CHANGES:

Class adds and scratches can only be made in the Horse Show Office and must be received prior to the start of the class. Class adds made on the day-of may also require the exhibitor to compete first in the order of go. No rider can participate in a class in which he or she is not entered. No additions will be allowed at the in-gates.

SCRATCHES:

If any entry is scratched in writing prior to noon on June 16th, 2019 entry fees will be refunded, less administration and stabling fees, which are NON-REFUNDABLE. After this time, no fees will be refunded without an original copy of a Doctor or Veterinarian certificate. The administration fee and stabling fee are non-refundable under any circumstances. Owners will be liable for all fees if not scratched in this manner.

HORSE SUBSTITUTIONS:

Horse substitutions will only be permitted prior to the closing date of entries at no charge.

PRIZE MONEY:

Every effort will be made to payout prize money at the end of the show or by etransfer/cheque within a week of the show's completion.

MEMBERSHIP RULES:

- All Canadian owners and riders must have a valid EC Gold or Bronze Sport License (A205-A207) OR purchase a Single Event Upgrade (A211 – not eligible for points) or License Transfer (A212) for a Silver or Bronze Sport License to Gold License; OR purchase a Temporary Sport License (A208 – not eligible for points)
- Competitors must have provincial territorial sport organization (PTSO) membership.
- NSHJA membership is required to participate and/or benefit in the NSHJA Programs.
- NOTE FOR CLASSES: ensure you have the correct sport licenses GOLD or BRONZE Exception: LEAD LINE riders only
 require NSEF or other PTSO membership.
- Amateur Riders: EC Amateur Status (A902)
- · Juniors: Date of Birth
- Horses & Ponies: A402 Horse Recordings are mandatory for all horses and ponies entering GOLD EC sanctioned competitions when required by discipline/breed sport rules and must be available at the competition (See Article A411 EC National Passport or FEI Passport Unavailable). Horse licenses are not required for horses competing in Bronze classes; however, if the competitor wishes to compete in Gold classes, they must purchase a temporary horse license or a permanent one.

ADMINISTRATION:

- Administration Fee: \$35.00Paramedic Fee: \$5.00
- Equine Medication Control: Any horse entered in any class at the competition may, while on the competition grounds be selected for equine medication control testing. An amount of \$7.00 for GOLD competitors and \$3.50 for BRONZE competitors will be added to the entry (amount to be remitted to Equestrian Canada).
- **JC Levy (GOLD)**: As a recognized national competition, an amount of **\$20.00** will be collected per horse entered in the Hunter divisions for remittance to the Jumping Committee, to support their development programs.
- **NSHJA Levy (BRONZE)**: As a bronze competitor, an amount of **\$8.00** will be collected per horse entered in the Hunter/Jumper divisions for remittance to the NSHJA, to support their development programs.

PONY MEASUREMENT:

Available on Friday, June 28th thirty minutes prior to the first pony EC rated class. Reserve through the Show Office. All ponies 8 years of age and younger will be measured if they do not have a temporary measurement card for the current year.

DOGS:

All dogs must always be on a leash. Owners are required to abide by the "Poop and Scoop" by-law.

NUMBERS:

A number will not be issued to anyone who has not paid or left an open cheque when the number is picked up. Every entry must be provided an identification number, which must always be worn and visible in the schooling/exercise areas as well as the competition ring. Any horse wearing the incorrect number may not be scored.

DRESS CODE:

Proper attire is required for all competitors starting Thursday morning and for the remainder of the show. Formal attire is encouraged for all stakes, classics and feature classes.

BLACKSMITHS:

A farrier is available during the days of competition. Payment must be made directly to the farrier once services have been rendered.

VETERINARIANS:

On call.

NO SMOKING:

There will be no smoking allowed in any building or within 10 meters of a public entrance as per the applicable by-laws.

SCHOOLING:

The ring will be available on Wednesday, June 26th, 2019 from 1:00pm - 6:00pm with a paid schooling ticket. A fee of \$25.00 must be paid in advance through your entry or at the show office. A maximum of five ponies/horses are permitted in the schooling ring at one time. Pre-arranged times may be available for groups.

LUNGING:

Lunging is available in the designated area only (in the grass field).

HELMETS:

Helmets are mandatory and must be worn by anyone mounted on a horse on the show grounds, with safety harness correctly fastened. It is the responsibility of the rider, the parent/guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to confirm headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards, is properly fitted, and in good condition (A905, G102).

VEHICLES:

All vehicles must be parked in designated areas only.

HORS CONCOURS:

As per A808, there will be no HORS Concours allowed in any class.

WASH RACKS:

Participants are only allowed to bathe their ponies/horses in designated area.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES

These trophies are presented each year. Trophies must be returned to the Show Committee by March 1st of the following year.

SCHOOLING CLASSES

WEDNESDAY – OPEN SCHOOLING ENTRY FEE \$25

Class #1 - The ring will be opened on Wednesday, June 26th 1:00pm - 6:00pm with a paid schooling ticket. The fee must be paid in advance through your entry or at the show office. A maximum of five ponies/horses are permitted in the schooling ring at one time. Pre-arranged times may be available for groups.

THURSDAY –SCHOOLING HUNTER ENTRY FEE \$25

Class #1B: Available to any pony/horse competing on Thursday, June 27th. Must be completed before their first over fences course entered. Ponies/horses are allowed **ONE** schooling round. No ribbons or prize money.

FRIDAY – SCHOOLING HUNTER ENTRY FEE \$25 Class #2: Available to any pony/horse competing on Friday,

June 28th. Must be completed before their first over fences course entered. Ponies/horses are allowed **ONE** schooling round. No ribbons or prize money.

SATURDAY – SCHOOLING HUNTER ENTRY FEE \$25

Class #2B: Available to any pony/horse competing on Saturday, June 29th. Must be completed before their first over fences course entered. Ponies/horses are allowed **ONE** schooling round. No ribbons or prize money.

PLEASE NOTE: NO SCHOOLING TRIPS ON SUNDAY

BRONZE HUNTER CLASSES

Classes in these divisions are not rated for EC awards, but will be awarded Nova Scotia Hunter Jumper Association Year End Awards. A NSHJA fee of \$8.00 will be collected on behalf of the NSHJA from bronze competitors to aid in the management of these awards and year end banquet.

NOVICE

EC membership not required for Leadline riders; NSEF or equivalent PTSO membership is required for insurance purposes. All other competitors in NOVICE must have a valid BRONZE membership (G107.5). No prize money.

CLASS #62: LEAD LINE

ENTRY FEE \$20

Entry fee covers all class and administration costs. Open to pony or horse to be ridden by a child 8 years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year. To walk, trot/jog and be led by an adult. Riders in this class are not permitted to enter any other class.

DIVISION #16: WALK/TROT

ENTRY FEE \$45

For inexperienced riders under the age of 10 as of January 1st. English or Western tack. Horses or Ponies. Does not affect green status. Riders in these classes are permitted to enter Pre-Short Stirrup (Crossrails) Hunter.

DIVISION #17: PRE-SHORT STIRRUP (CROSSRAILS) HUNTER

ENTRY FEE \$45

Class #66/67/68: Open to Junior and Senior riders.

BRONZE HUNTER DIVISIONS

Classes in these divisions are not rated for EC awards, but will be awarded Nova Scotia Hunter Jumper Association year end Awards. A NSHJA fee of \$8.00 will be collected on behalf of the NSHJA from bronze competitors to aid in the management of these awards and year end banquet. Bronze membership required.

DIVISION CHAMPIONS TO RECEIVE A COOLER AND A COMMEMERATIVE SILVER PLATE

These divisions are intended as an introduction to horse showing for riders and/or ponies/horses not ready for the regular pony and hunter divisions.

DIVISION #1: SHORT/LONG STIRRUP ENTRY FEE \$60 HUNTER

Class #: 3/4/5: Short Stirrup Hunter will be open to Junior "C" riders. Riders are classified as Junior "C" if they are under 12 on Jan.1. Long Stirrup Hunter will be open to Junior "B" and "A" riders. Riders are classified as a Junior "B" if they are 12,13 or 14 on Jan 1. Riders are classified Junior "A" if they are 15,16,17 on Jan 1. Riders in this division may only cross enter in the Walk/Trot/Canter and/or Equitation on the flat classes for their proper age category. Riders may show in non-rated classes that jumps do not exceed 2'3". Riders must enter and complete at least one over fences class in the division to be eligible to compete in the Under-Saddle Class. Ponies or horses may enter. Suitability is a factor. Horses and ponies may show in other classes with a different rider. This division will jump a course of hunter style jumps not to exceed 2'. Jogging for soundness is not required.

DIVISION #19: PONY DEVELOPMENT ENTRY FEE \$60

Class #(S-70/71/72) (M-70.1/71.1/72.1) (L-70.2/71.2/72.2): To prepare and develop future pony hunter riders and ponies. To be ridden by a junior in all phases of division. The same pony/rider combination cannot cross enter into rated pony hunter divisions. However, the pony/rider combination may enter EC Pony Hack or Short Stirrup. The rider may compete on another pony or horse in other divisions. Fences: Smalls 2'0" / Mediums 2'3" / Larges 2'6". Distances will be run similar to short stirrup. Jogging for soundness is not required. This division is kindly sponsored by bits N bridles.

DIVISION #2: LOW MODIFIED CHILD/ADULT HUNTER

ENTRY FEE \$60

There is no age limit for showing in this division.

Riders may NOT cross enter into any Rated Hunter Division.

Class #: 6/7/8: Open to all children and adult amateur rider designations as per EC rules, guidelines, and limitations. Courses will be made up of hunter style jumps and set at a height not to exceed 2.3". Classes will be run per EC rules, guidelines, and limitations. Rider may enter Jumper classes with heights no more than 0.8m. Jogging for soundness is not required. This division is kindly sponsored by Daniels Farrier Service.

DIVISION #3: MODIFIED CHILD/ADULT HUNTER

ENTRY FEE \$60

There is no age limit for showing in this division.
Riders may NOT cross enter into any Rated Hunter Division.

Class #: 9/10/11: Open to all children and adult amateur rider designations as per EC rules, guidelines, and limitations. Courses will be made up of hunter style jumps and set at a height not to exceed 2.6". Classes will be run per EC rules, guidelines, and limitations. Rider may enter Jumper classes with heights no more than 0.9m. Showing in this division will affect a horse's eligibility. Jogging for soundness is not required. This division is kindly sponsored by WS Langley Concrete & Materials Technology Inc.

DIVISION #4: BABY GREEN HUNTER ENTRY FEE \$60

Class #: 12/13/14: Open to horses that have not competed in an EC sanctioned Gold or Silver competition (or equivalent) prior to January 1st of the current year. To maintain their Baby Green status, horses may not compete in any over fences division at an EC sanctioned competition higher than 2'6". Height is 2'6". Jogging for soundness is not required.

2'6" HORSE HUNTER STAKE

CLASS #50: \$300 INTERCITY INSURANCE ENTRY FEE \$30 SERVICES 2'6" HORSE HUNTER STAKE

Open to all horses competing in 2'6" or lower (Modified or Low Modified Hunter). Not open to Baby Green horses if they have not competed in the Modified or Low Modified Hunter. Prize Payout: \$90 / \$75 / \$60 / \$45 / \$30



Medal Classes

CLASS #73: MY FIRST MEDAL

ENTRY FEE \$25

Riders may enter this class if they have not jumped over 2'3" at the same show. To be judged as a hunt seat equitation medal class. Fence height 2'. Riders cannot cross enter into any other medal classes. Not open to competitors showing in an EC recognized over fences division. EC Bronze requirements. Sponsorship prizes for the class and year end awards kindly provided by Ponyistas.

CLASS #74: NSHJA PONY MEDAL ENTRY FEE \$25

Ribbons 1-8, NSHJA will provide Gold, Silver and Bronze medals to the competition. There will be a year-end champion and reserve champion. EC Nonrated class. It is open to Junior riders on ponies, not competing in divisions that are 1.0m (3'3) or higher at the same show. Fence heights, rider age and pony heights as per EC Rules. This is a hunter style course. Open numerical scoring. Course must have at least one test. Medal rounds to be completed on an open card while fences set at applicable pony height.





- 1. In this competition, a certain number of obstacles are set up in the arena. Each obstacle carries from 10 to 120 points according to its difficulty. Combination obstacles are not allowed.
- 2. The obstacles must be built so that they can be jumped in both directions.
- 3. The points allocated to the obstacles may be repeated at the discretion of the Course Designer. If it is not possible to place 12 obstacles in the arena, it is up the him/her to delete the obstacles he/she wishes.
- 4. The Athlete is credited with the number of points carried by each obstacle that he/she has jumped correctly. No points are awarded for an obstacle knocked down.
- 5. A fixed time of 45 seconds (minimum) to 90 seconds (maximum) is allocated in this Competition. During this time, the Athlete may jump any of the obstacles he/she wishes in any order and in any direction. He/She may cross the starting line in either direction. (The starting line must be provided with four flags there must be a red and a white flag at each end of the line.) During his/her round, the Athlete is permitted to cross the starting and finishing lines in either direction, as often as he/she wishes.
- 6. The bell is rung to declare the end of the fixed time during which points may be obtained. The Athlete must then cross the finishing line in one direction or the other in order for his time to be recorded; if he/she does not cross the finish line he/she is eliminated. The finishing line must be provided with four flags there must be a red and a white flag at each end of the line.
- 7. If the fixed time is reached at the moment when the horse is already taking off at an obstacle, this obstacle is included in the Athlete's Score if it is jumped correctly.
- 8. Any obstacle knocked down during a round will not be rebuilt; if it is jumped again, no points will be credited to the Athlete. The same applies for knocking down an obstacle as a result of a Disobedience or for displacing a lower part of an obstacle,

- which is positioned in the same vertical plan as the highest part. In the case of a Disobedience without a knock-down, the Athlete may jump that obstacle or continue to another obstacle.
- 9. Each obstacle may be jumped twice. The act, voluntarily or not, of jumping an obstacle for the third time or of passing between the flags of an obstacle already knocked down does not incur elimination. However, the Athlete does not score the points allotted to this obstacle.
- 10. All disobediences are penalized by the time lost by the Athlete. A fall of Horse or Athlete is penalized by Elimination (see JRs Art. 241.3.25).
- 11. The Athlete who has obtained the highest number of points will be declared the winner. In the event of equality of points, the fastest time taken between the start of the fixed time and the crossing of the finishing line after the bell has been rung will decide. In the event of equality of points and time for first place, there will be a jump-off according to the same formula with a fixed time of 40 seconds.
- 12. An obstacle may be provided in the course duly marked by flags and called "JOKER". The Joker may be jumped twice; 200 points are awarded each time this obstacle is jumped correctly, but if it is knocked down, 200 points must be deducted from the total points obtained so far by the Athlete.

The Jody Burbidge Memorial Sportsmanship Award




