Objective:


This two day clinic with FEI 5* Dressage Judge, Elizabeth (Lib) McMullen is an opportunity for our riders, coaches, and judges expand their knowledge and understanding of:

- What top international dressage judges are looking for at the various competition levels
- The marking scale and the criteria judges use when assessing and marking the movements at the different levels
- · Common errors and how to avoid them
- How to present a polished test

Ride Format:

- 1. Each rider will ride their test twice in the same session
- 2. To expedite the auditors learning, Lib will be wearing a microphone so that the auditors will hear her scores and comments for each rider's first test.
- 3. At the end of the first test-ride Lib will have the liberty to open a brief discussion with the auditors and then work with the rider and their coach to improve individual movements/scores.
- 4. Rider will re-ride the test which will be scored by the auditors and Lib.
- 5. At the end of the test, Lib will go over her score sheet movement by movement providing her mark and rationale for the score.
- 6. Rider's will receive Lib's score sheets for both of their tests

CLINIC FORMAT

Saturday, June 22, 2019

9:00AM-10:00AM - A one-hour introductory lecture as 2-3 demonstration riders demonstrate individual movements while Lib:

- · Grades and critiques the movements
- Explains why she awarded the various scores and how the rider can improve the score

10:15AM - 4:30PM

- 6-40 minute test-ride sessions, Training Level to Prix St. George with a one hour break for lunch
- Each rider will ride a pre-determined test twice.
- Auditors will "judge" each rider's second test.

End of Day Wrap-up (15-20 minutes - longer if needed)

Lib will answer questions that auditors submitted during the day and then open the floor for questions and discussion.

8-40 minute Test Ride sessions - same format as Saturday
