- The Jumper Division has two classes (One Welcome and one Speed class) with .75m and .85m heights combined. Please indicate on entry form which height you intend to jump.
- Divisions may be cancelled and/or combined if there are insufficient entries on the closing date. Divisions may be split if the numbers of entries deem it so.
