Equestrian Nova Scotia Trail Ride & Drive Information

- Parking There will be volunteers to assist with parking locations
- Armbands All riders/drivers and volunteers have armbands with their emergency information inside. If you do not have an armband, you can rent or purchase one for \$10.
- Lunch Each participant will be given a coupon for one food item and one drink from the canteen. Other food/drink products will be available for purchase.
- PrepareIt is hard to get lost on the trails but it could be disorienting so it doesn't hurt to be prepared. We
recommend carrying with you a whistle, compass, personal water, snack, horse bells and a cell phone.
Please stay on the marked trails and wear hunters orange, if possible.

There is a scavenger set up! You will be provided with a map of the facility, watering locations,
For Fun emergency numbers, etc. This is not a guided ride/drive. When you arrive, register and off you go...
There will be different areas throughout the trails where you can take photos with trail signs- to show where you've been. There will be a draw for prizes at the end of the day!

General Information

- > Rider and the owner of the horse must be a 2024 Equestrian Nova Scotia Member
- Ride Time 10:30 am -2:30 pm ... You can ride as long as you wish, please stay on trails and road ways and off grassy areas. We would like everyone off the trails and accounted for by 2:30 pm. That gives daylight hours to locate anyone who has not checked out.
- > Aside from thunder, lightning and hurricanes ... this is a rain or shine event.
- Basic Horse and Human First Aid Kits will be onsite with volunteers. Volunteers will be on site and on trails if needed.
- > Avon Animal Hospital Veterinary will be on call in the event of an emergency.
- Walk, Trot or Jog are the only acceptable gaits on the trails. Only trot/ jog when you can clearly see the trail ahead of you.
- Riders/drivers will not have to pick up manure along the trail while riding/driving ... We will clean trails after everyone has left. Please clean up around your trailer area before leaving.
- Accessible Trails will be marked.

What you will need to bring with you

- ASTM or BSI Approved Helmet
- Whatever you need/want on the trail to make you and your horse comfortable
- Bring a filled water bottle for yourself, there will be some water available for sale on site.
- Suntan lotion/Fly spray
- There will be water available for the horses... but please bring your own hay, feed and water (if your horse has a tendency to not drink unfamiliar water).
- If your horse falls into any of these categories, please mark their tail with large visible ribbon, thank you.

Red Ribbon - Tendency to Kick Green Ribbon - Inexperienced or Green Yellow Ribbon - Stallion
