



## **Coach Cohorts-Fall 2024**

**What is a cohort?** A virtual training, mentoring, and certification opportunity for Instructor or Competition Coach candidates or professional development for coaches.

**When and how?** This cohort will kick off on October 22, 2024 and will work together for 12-15 sessions until the Spring. The sessions will be held via Zoom. All sessions in the cohort begin at 7:00pm AST and session lengths vary. See Schedule below for course dates and times. The full cohort is encouraged but we will have other registration options.

### **Why the cohort approach?**

The cohorts have been developed to address several issues candidates commonly face:

- 1) Evaluation Prep – Without a mentor, access to training and clear instructions of what is expected, evaluations can be very stressful for candidates. The cohort provides excellent and knowledgeable mentors and clear information on the current program requirements.
- 2) Cost – Traditional coach certification is expensive. The cohort offers a cost-effective learning environment with mentoring, training, networking and an optional low-cost evaluation fee (i.e. reduced travel costs, better preparation for the evaluation, more frequent shorter training times to allow a coach to work around their coaching and other life situations and avoid given up a full day of coaching or life, etc.)
- 3) Inefficient Process – Traditionally, candidates have felt overwhelmed and take longer to complete certification requirements. The cohort provides clear resources, a step-by-step process, time-commitment expectations and supports – from beginning to your successful end!
- 4) Location – It can be difficult for coaches to travel to mentors, training, and evaluations. The cohort removes that barrier as it is virtual (for the most part).

### **Registration Options:**

**Full Cohort** - This includes learning sessions, NCCP Equestrian Theory Modules, Lesson Review. Also provided is the opportunity for certification video evaluation. (eligibility restrictions and additional fees apply).

**Theory Modules Only** – NCCP Long-Term Equestrian Development (LTED), NCCP Plan an Equestrian Practice, & NCCP Analyzing Equestrian Performance. These modules can also be signed up for individually.

**If you have already taken the Equestrian Theory Modules and wish to participate in the Cohort, please reach out to Sheila to discuss options.**

**We encourage participants to sign up for the full cohort.** However, we recognize that this may not be a possibility. We offer registration alternatives on an "as needed" basis. Again, please reach out to Sheila to discuss.

**Registration Deadline:** Tuesday, October 1st, 2024. We encourage early registration as a payment plan may be available.
