### Eligibility:


- To become a recognized Scotia Series Official, applicants must:
- Be a member in good standing with Equestrian Nova Scotia.
- Be 19 years of age or older. Those aged 16-18 can be "in-training".
- Have competition experience relevant to the position will be required for some disciplines.
- -Submit an application to Equestrian NS and complete the requirements of the officials program.
- Please note: equivalency may be granted for some components based on previous certifications or experience.
