- 80 - 89 - Good to very good, an excellent horse with minor mistakes
- 70 - 79 - Average / or a good horse with minor mistakes
- 60 - 69 - poor or below average performance with minor mistakes, no major faults
- 50 - 59 - one major fault, hind end knockdown, adding a stride in an in and out, very bad fence, dropping a leg, trotting on course, disunited
- 40 - 49 - Serious major fault, front end knockdown, refusal, extremely dangerous jumping
- 30 - 39 - two or more serious faults
- 10 - 29 - very unsafe but avoids elimination
- 0 - eliminated
