

Hunter Over Poles Can be judged much like Hunter Over Fences however, while the form over the fence is not being judged, the approach, step over the pole, lines, turns/corners are. We are looking for a fluid, forward and consistent pace showing a horse/pony with a willing attitude and responsiveness to the rider. Safety and control are paramount. Refer to judging of hunter o/f for mor detail on this.

- good line/pole
- ~ crooked approach
- + not centered over pole
- ~— hesitation at pole
- touched pole
- == stepped on pole
- (R) refusal
- (Sh) shying on course
- cut corner
- (XL) wrong lead (if cantering)
- (dis) disunited (if cantering)

- stride changes (speeding up / slowing down)
- ears pinned / back
